EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION POLICY
FOR SESSION : 2023-24

GENERAL INFORMATION

- It is compulsory for all the students to have 80% attendance to appear in the both Periodic Tests & Terminal Exams as well.
- **PROMOTION** to next class will be based on four evaluation cycles (i.e 2 periodic tests-July/December & 2 terminal exams September/March). Syllabus for the whole year will be divided accordingly and each part will be assessed as per CBSE GUIDELINES.

Synopsis of Assessment:

For class I-III

- 1) Internal Assessment (20 marks each in Term-I & Term-II) which includes the following:
 - a) Periodic Test (In July/August and December/January) 20marks
 - b) Notebook submission (Once in Term-I & Term-II separately) 5 marks
 - c) Subject Enrichment Activity (Once in Term-I & Term-II separately) 5 marks
 - d) Multiple Assessment (once in Term -I & Term-II separately) 5 marks
- 2) Mid Term exams (In September) 30 marks
- 3) Annual Exam (In March) 30 marks

Thus, Term-I: 50marks (Periodic Test- 5 marks +notebook submission- 5 marks + Subject Enrichment- 5 marks + multiple assessment-5marks + mid-term exams- 30marks)

Term-II: 50 marks (Periodic Test- 5 marks + Note Book- 5 marks + Subject Enrichment- 5 marks + Multiple assessment- 5 marks +AE- 30 marks)

For class IV & V

- 1) Internal Assessment (20 marks each in Term-I & Term-II) which includes the following:
 - a) Periodic Test (In July/August and December/January) 20marks
 - b) Portfolio (Once in Term-I & Term-II separately) 5 marks
 - c) Subject Enrichment Activity (Once in Term-I & Term-II separately) 5 marks
 - d) Multiple Assessment (once in Term -I & Term-II separately) 5 marks
- 2) Mid Term exams (In September) 40 marks will be converted into 30 marks.
- 3) Annual Exam (In March) 40 marks will be converted into 30 marks.

Thus, Term-I: 50 marks (Periodic Test- 5 marks + Portfolio - 5 marks + Subject Enrichment- 5 marks + multiple assessment- 5 marks + mid-term exams- 30marks)

Term-II: 50 marks (Periodic Test- 5 marks +Portfolio - 5 marks + Subject Enrichment- 5 marks + Multiple assessment- 5 marks +AE- 30 marks)

PROMOTION POLICY

Thus, Term-I: 50marks (Periodic Test- 5 marks + portfolio- 5 marks + Subject Enrichment- 5 marks + multiple assessment- 5marks + mid-term exams- 30marks)

Term-II: 50 marks (Periodic Test-5marks + portfolio- 5 marks + Subject Enrichment- 5 marks + Multiple assessment- 5 marks +AE- 30 marks)

 - ❖ 30% of I Term + II Term (For class VIII)

PROMOTION POLICY

For Class VI-VIII a student must secure at least 33% marks in each subject studied.

For class IX -X

2) Mid Term exams (In September) 80 marks will be converted into 40 marks.

3) Annual Exam (In March) 80 marks will be converted into 40 marks.

In both the terms internal assessment of 20 marks will be converted into 10 marks.

Thus, Term-I: 50marks (Periodic Test- 5 marks +portfolio- 5 marks + Subject Enrichment- 5 marks + multiple assessment- 5marks) will be converted into 10 marks + mid-term exams- 40 marks)

Term-II: 50 marks (Periodic Test- 5marks + portfolio- 5 marks + Subject Enrichment- 5 marks + Multiple assessment- 5 marks) will be converted into 10 marks +AE-40marks

In class X marks of internal assessment obtained by students on the basis of whole year performance (out of - 20 marks) will be sent to Board by school and Annual exam will be conducted by board for 80 marks.

PROMOTION POLICY

For Class IX, a student must secure at least 33% marks in each subject studied.

And for class X, a student must secure at least 33% marks in each subject studied.

*For class XI & XII *

In class XII marks of practical (out of - 20 marks) will be sent to Board by external examiners and Annual exam will be conducted by board for 80 marks.

- Select response type questions (MCQ) = 20%
- Constructed response questions (Short Answer/Long Answer type Questions, as per existing pattern) = 30%

***For class XI & XII ***

- Competency Focused Questions in the form of MCQs/Case Based Questions, Source-based Integrated Questions or any other type = 40%
- Select response type questions (MCQ) = 20%
- Constructed response questions (Short Answer Questions/Long Answer type Questions, as per existing pattern) = 40%
